

## Zoom Music Mode

**To set your audio settings to be optimized for Music Mode:** Find SETTINGS on the Zoom app: Gear icon in the upper right of the app, or go to Preferences. SETTINGS>AUDIO (left hand column)

**Speaker** -Choose same as system, or built in output (internal speakers) *(if you are using an external speaker over than your device you would need to choose the name of that particular device)*

**Output volume** -Test your speaker to hear what you will hear—then, move the toggle accordingly -**\*UNSELECT\*** - Use separate audio device to play ringtone simultaneously

**Microphone** -Choose same as system or built in output if you are using your device's microphone *(if you have an external microphone you would need to select that microphone's name)* -**\*UNSELECT\*** - Automatically adjust microphone volume

**Suppress background noise** -Choose: "LOW" **Click "Advanced" at the bottom of Audio window** -Echo cancellation - choose "auto" -**\*Select\*** "show in meeting option to enable original sound" from microphone -**\*Unselect\*** disable echo cancellation -**\*Select\*** High Fidelity Music Mode -**\*Select\*** use stereo audio (if this setting does not show up- log in to your account on [zoom.com](https://zoom.com), go to Settings>scroll down>enable Use Stereo Audio) **Note:** These are the audio setting options if you are using a laptop/desktop. For iPhone/iPad, the audio settings options are limited, but you should still complete this update and "enable original sound" (On an iPad, you would select Settings>Meetings>and scroll down until you see "use original sound">select that)
